#### 2 **5 Definitions**

3		In this Act, unless the contrary intention appears:
4		Personal information means the same definition under the Privacy
5		Act 1988.
6 7		<i>Medical treatment</i> refers to *hormone replacement therapy or *sex affirmation surgery.
8 9	Note:	For the avoidance of doubt, undergoing medical treatment can mean either undoing hormone replacement therapy, sex affirmation surgery, or both.
10		Change of sex refers to when a person undergoes *medical
11		treatment to have the sexual characteristics of their new sex.
12		Hormone replacement therapy means the administration of sex
13		hormones to transgender or intersex individuals for the purpose of
14		more closely aligning their secondary sexual characteristics with
15		their new sex.
16		Sex affirmation surgery means a surgical procedure (or procedure)
17		by which a transgender or intersex person's physical appearance
18		and function of their existing sexual characteristics are altered to
19		resemble that of their new sex.

6 A	pplications
	<ol> <li>A person of either sex who is aged at least 18 years may make an application for their sex to be changed on their *personal information on the basis of undergoing a *medical treatment.</li> </ol>
	(2) A person of either sex who is aged younger than 18 years but no younger than 16 years may make an application under the provisions of subsection (1), subject to the approval of a magistrate.
	(3) An application is to be determined by a Sex Recognition Panel.
	(4) An application is to be submitted to any of the office branches in any state/territory capital city.
7 D	etermination of application
	(1) In the case of an application the Panel must grant the application if satisfied that the applicant:
	(a) has lived in their new sex for a period of at least 1 year; and
	(b) has undergone *medical treatment.
	(2) The Panel may reject an application if there is insufficient evidence that the panel is satisfied that the requirements under subsection (1) have been met.

	(1) An application must include:
	(a) a report made by two different registered medical practitioners; or
	(b) a report made by a chartered psychologist; or
	(c) medical history of *medical treatment.
